We are committed to cleaning and sanitizing our spaces to keep our customers and employees safe. Our meeting spaces are already carefully cleaned between meeting room reservations. Our office spaces are also cleaned thoroughly on a regular basis.

Given the current situation, we are enhancing our regular cleaning policies for both our meeting and office spaces. We are using disinfecting products that are Health Canada-approved and giving special attention to frequently touched surfaces, such as tables, countertops, doorknobs, light switches, sink faucets and coffee station.

Our goal is to reduce the risk that a customer or employee might contract or inadvertently spread the virus. There are small but impactful ways that you can help us keep our spaces clean:

Keeping yourself healthy. We're reminding all customers to continue to wash your hands when you arrive at the office, after using the bathroom, and if you blow your nose or cough. It is recommended to scrub your hands with soap and running water for 20 seconds. If water isn't available, please use hand sanitizer.

Staying home if you're sick. If you're feeling sick or have cold and flu-like symptoms, please stay home.
